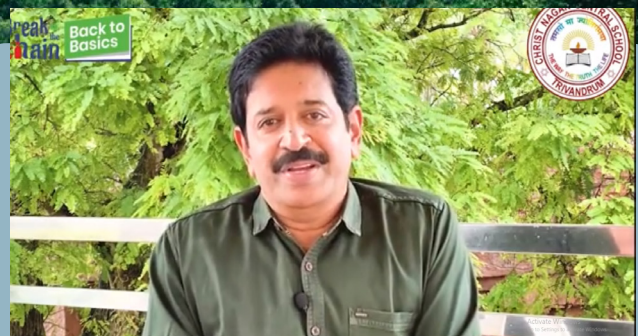
We salute the assiduous and earnest teachers of Christ Nagar for their undying spirit in

“He who plants trees loves others besides himself”

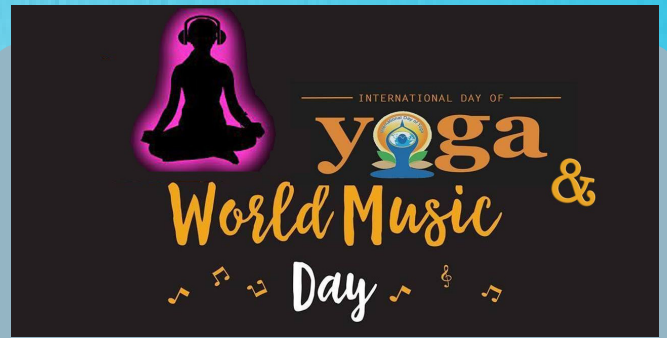
