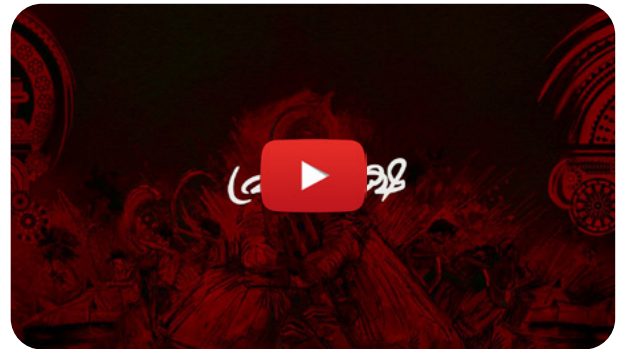

## MPSMUN 2020

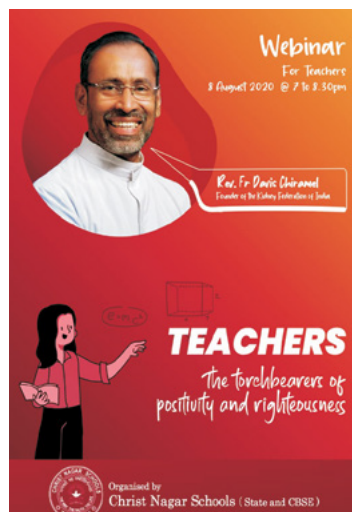
