display of yoga and Zumba dance added colour to


the inaugural ceremony.








The class 12 students offered a congenial and harmonious welcome to their Class 11 juniors with challenging games and breathtaking band performance.

Mahatma Gandhi Rashtrabhasha Prachar Sabha Examinations were conducted for classes 1 to 10. 307 students registered and wrote the examination.


